



## **Doral Park Tennis Club Rules & Regulations - Updated March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**

1. The Doral Park Country Club (“the Club”) Tennis center is for Members and their guests only. The Tennis center enforces a strict No Smoking Policy as no smoking is allowed anywhere on the Tennis Center grounds.
2. “Tennis Member” shall mean a person who holds a Tennis Membership in the Club.
3. “Tennis Membership” shall include such rights and obligations as provided in any membership plan for Tennis Members established and amended by the Club from time to time. Tennis Membership is separate and distinct from the Club Social Membership, as Tennis Members include Doral Park residents and dues-paying non-residents, while Club Social Membership is limited to HOA –paying Doral Park residents.
4. All Tennis Members must be active and accounts must be up to date in order to use the Tennis Center.
5. Play is subject to availability for walk in Members and guests.
6. All members and guests must register, present their Membership Card and make full payment at the pro-shop before commencing play.
7. Only Staff Professionals with proper registration are permitted to train or teach at the Club.
8. **Reservations:** Reservations may be made up to two days in advance of play, online by creating an account on <https://playbycourt.com/>. The following rules apply to play pursuant to reservations:
  8. 1. All players’ names must be listed on the reservation including any guest(s).
  - 8.2. Full Payment must be made prior to play.
  - 8.3. Unless you give the Tennis Center prior notice that you will be late, your court reservation will be cancelled if you fail to show up with-in 15 minutes of your registered time. If you are late, and there is another reservation for your court after hours, you may only play the originally reserved time.
  - 8.4. Reservations must be cancelled in a timely manner (a minimum of 2 hours’ notice). Failure to timely cancel reservations may lead to the suspension of the privilege to make advance reservations.
  - 8.5 Reservations are not transferable.

9. Scheduled Club events take preference over other activities. Should your reservation be affected by a later scheduled Club activity, you will be given an opportunity to make a new reservation at another available time and date.
10. Tennis classes, clinics and camps must be prepaid.
11. There is a minimum 12 Hour cancellation policy for all Tennis Lessons. Failure to timely cancel a tennis lesson will result in forfeiture of the payment.
12. **General Tennis Club Rules:**
  - 12.1. Proper Tennis Attire is required at all times.
  - 12.2. Only standard tennis shoes with non-marking soles are allowed on the Courts. No running shoes.
  - 12.3. Proper tennis etiquette is required at all time. No foul language or disruptive behavior will be tolerated.
  - 12.4. Members & their guests shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner with due regard to the authority of club staff, officials, senior and junior members and the rights of opponents, spectators and visitors.
  - 12.5. Management reserves the right to remove a member or guest due to improper behavior or by a violation of any of the tennis rules.
  - 12.6. Maximum of only 6 tennis balls per court.
  - 12.7. Tennis basket playing time must be approved by the director and may only be played (as approved) on weekdays between 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. and weekends between 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Otherwise, no tennis baskets are allowed on the courts.
13. Guest passes are limited to the same guest once a month regardless of which member has invited them. Guest fees are \$10 for a resident member guest, \$15 for non-resident members' guest, and \$20 for all other guests.
14. Guest passes may not be used for League matches, Best of Miami, All Island.
15. Members are limited to one time slot when others are waiting.
16. League policies: Captain works with Tennis center manager to clear dates for league play, then manager will post team sign-up notice for two weeks in office. After two weeks, if team is not filled, non-member players may fill out the team (It is recommended that no more than 3 outside players be allowed per team). Non-member league players will pay \$10 per official team practice or home team match.
